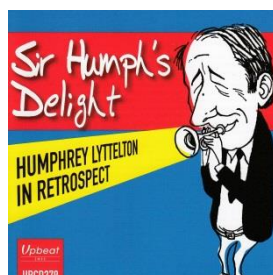


**NEW! DIZ DISLEY – With Me Little Ukulele in Me Hand!**

**URCD280 1 CD £12.99**

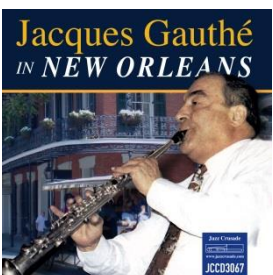
This album is a true labour of love by one of British Jazz's genuine originals paying tribute to one of variety's immortals. Altogether the mood created by Diz and his choice of jazz musicians is one of sheer mischievous joy, evoking effortlessly the nostalgically raffish feel of a stroll along Blackpool's slightly seedy Golden Mile many years ago. The CD includes two titles not recorded by Formby – *I Was Wagging My Magical Wand* and *I Showed Me Testimonial*. With Diz here are Alan Cooper, Alan Rogers, Martin Fry and Colin Bowden. Great Album running 33 fun-filled minutes.



**NEW! HUMPHREY LYTTTELTON – Sir Humph's Delight**

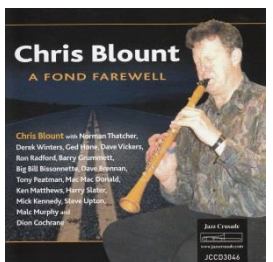
This richly varied anthology covers several contrasting aspects of Humphrey Lyttelton's long career from the 50s to the 80s all chosen by Mike Pointon. Bands include his Big Band and the Paseo Band and artists include Jimmy Rushing, Kenny Davern, Johnny Parker, Bruce Turner, Micky Ashman, Ian Armit, John Barnes, Pete Strange, Colin Bowden and many more. Album runs 69.07 minutes.



**REISSUED! JACQUES GAUTHÉ - In New Orleans**

A native of Gascony, France, Gauthé, renowned clarinet and saxophone player, studied under Claude Luter but his life was transformed when he met Sidney Bechet in Paris in the late 1950s who became his mentor and friend. He is about as close to the playing of Sidney Bechet as it is possible to be. The session on this CD was recorded in New Orleans at the Jazzology Studios in October 2000 and all the personnel are exceptional. In addition to Jacques Gauthé on clarinet and soprano sax, there is Reide Kaiser at the piano, Emil Mark banjo, Colin Bray string bass and Taff Lloyd on drums



**REISSUED! CHRIS BLOUNT – A Fond Farewell**

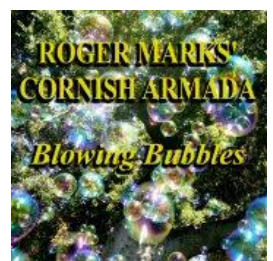
Three sessions feature on this disc and serve as a fitting reminder of a great clarinet player! The first was recorded in Barnes, London in December 1995. The second at the Bude Jazz Festival in August 1993, and the third in Nottingham in April 1996. So Chris is gone, but his music lives on in these recordings, including tracks that you will not have heard before! Personnel over the three recordings include Chris Blount, Norman Thatcher, Dave Vickers, Big Bill Bissonnette, Dave Brennan, Mick Kennedy, Ken Matthews, Malc Murphy, and Steve Upton.



**NEW! THE SWEET & HOT QUARTET – Play It Sweet & Hot!**

Here is the first recording by a marvellous quartet of supremely talented musicians who need no introduction - Jeff Barnhart (piano & vocals); Anne Barnhart (flute & vocals); Tom "Spats" Langham (banjo, guitar & vocals) and Graham Smith (traps and washboard). They play an astonishingly wide range of musical styles - ragtime to swing, blues to bounce, and show tunes to ballads and jazz standards - all with great panache and enthusiasm. You certainly can't pigeon-hole this band! The CD was recorded over two days in May 2017 (not live sessions).



**NEW! ROGER MARKS' CORNISH ARMADA – Blowing Bubbles**

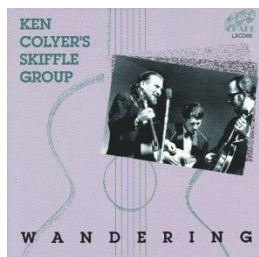
**PKCD412 1 CD £12.99**

This, the second CD for P.E.K. by Roger Marks' excellent band, was recorded at Sutton Coldfield Jazz Club in July 2017 when the band were on fine form at the start of their tour of the Midlands. Their brand of relaxed good-time jazz appeals to the dancers at jazz clubs, so no frantic over-fast tempos here. Very enjoyable! The line-up is Graham Trevarton, Gordon Stafford, Roger Marks, Malcolm Hurrell, Tony Mann & Dave Cawse.

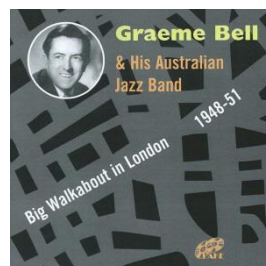
